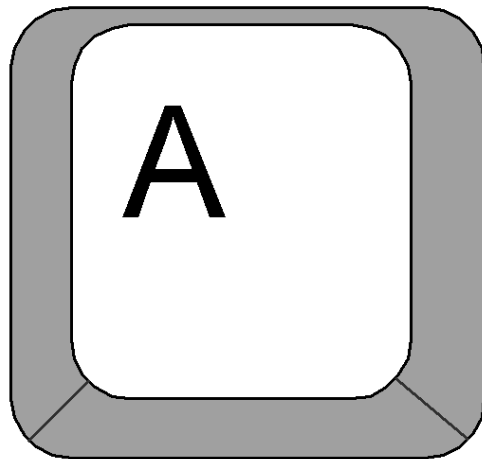
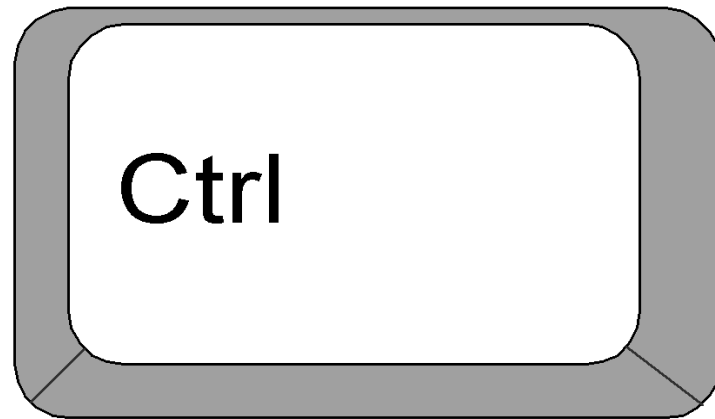
- A folder on the hard drive set up for video. It is also a fail safe place to save if the usershare goes down

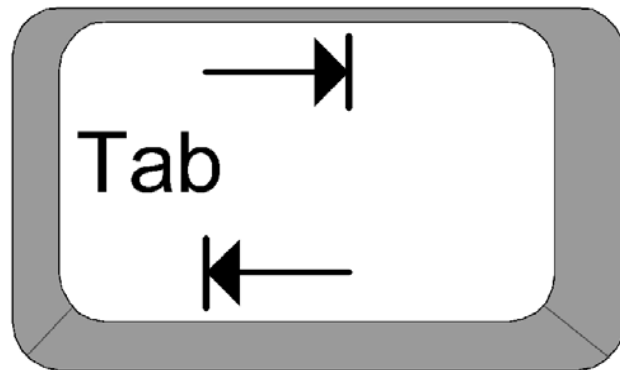

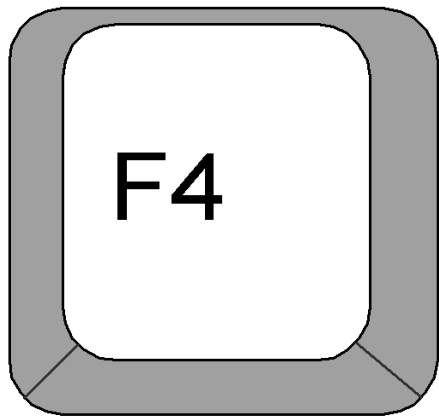

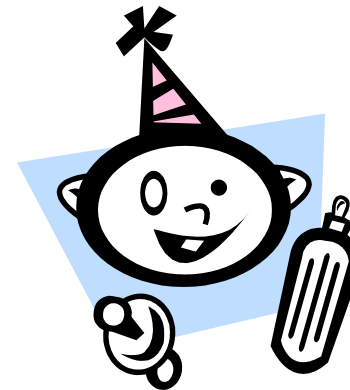

□ Cliché

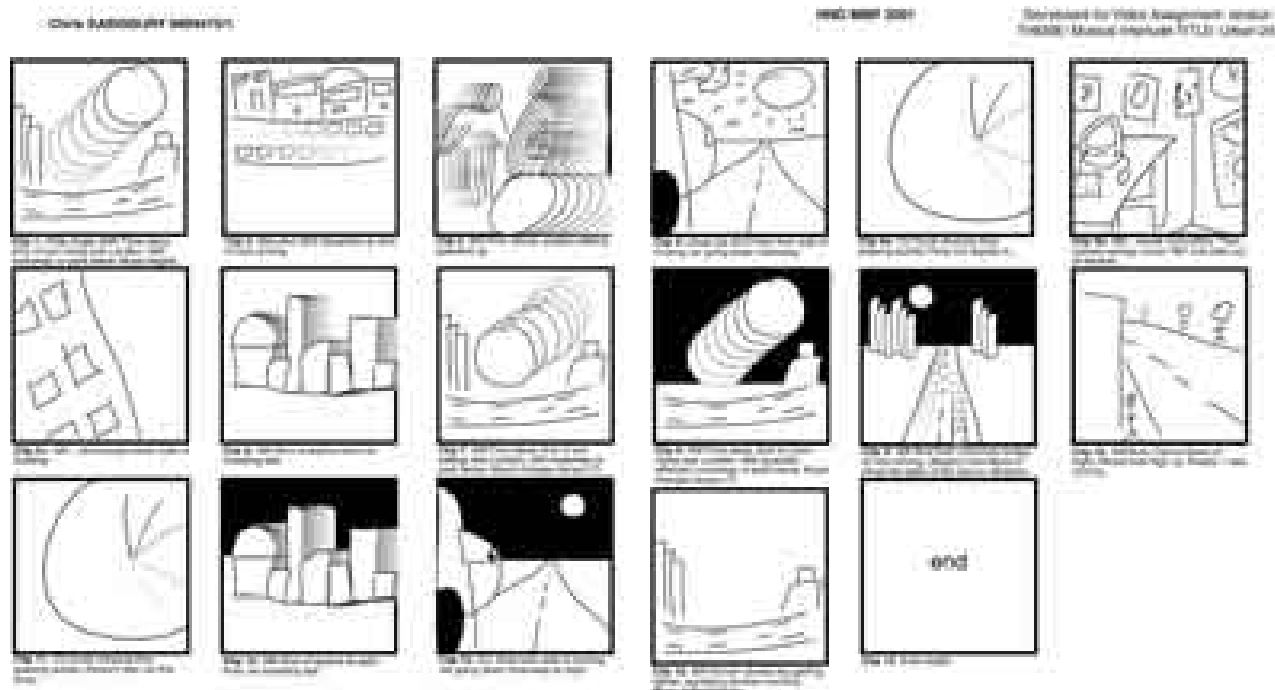
- an expression that has been worn out through constant use. Ex.: "short but sweet"

□ Storyboard

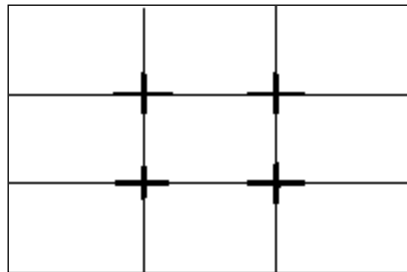
- A sequential series of sketches illustrating stages or scenes in a production. Used as a visual script or shooting plan.

- Imaginary lines are drawn dividing the image into thirds both horizontally and vertically. You place important elements of your composition where these lines intersect.

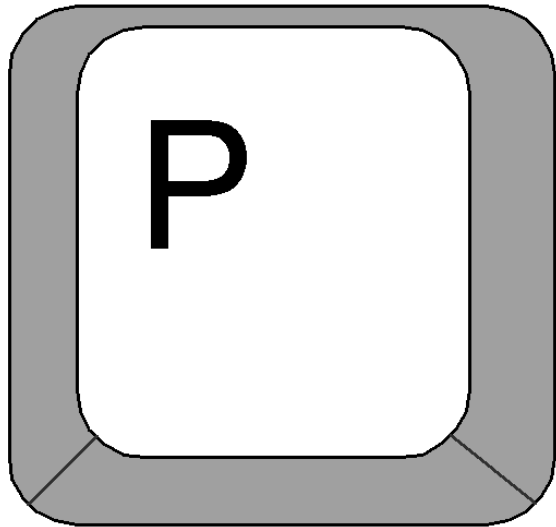

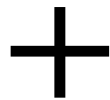
- Toggle Premiere's Palettes on and off.

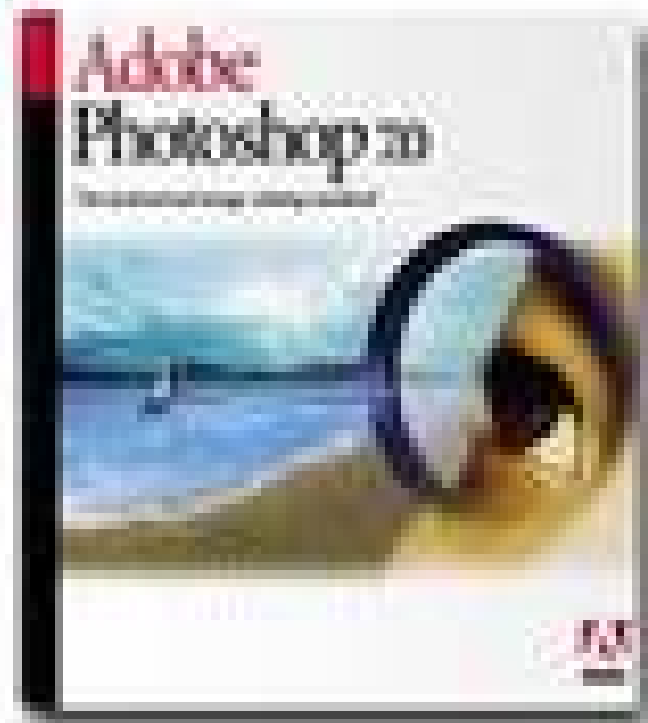

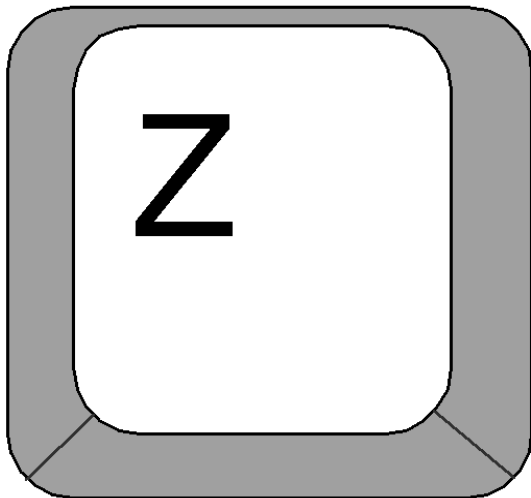
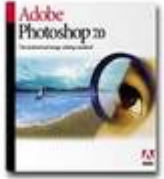

- The plus key { + } and minus key { - } on the main keyboard (NOT the numeric keypad) will expand and contract the time scale in the Timeline window.

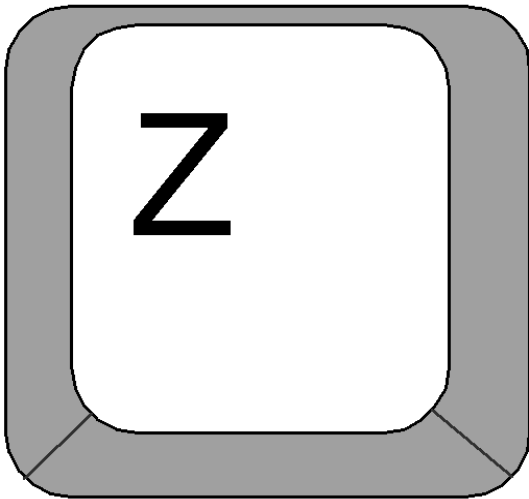
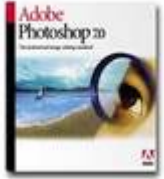
